

About KHC Measurement Work

The Kentuckiana Health Collaborative (KHC) is a non-profit coalition of members representing providers, payers, purchasers, and consumers that distributes annual consolidated measurement reports to physicians, nurse practitioners, and physician assistants in Kentucky and Southern Indiana. Data supplied in these reports allows for comparison to local and state average and benchmark scores on the quality of care patients received on a variety of ambulatory care indicators. Each year, health plans supply administrative data from their annual National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA) Healthcare Effectiveness Data & Information Set (HEDIS®) submissions to the KHC for aggregation.
