Amy Goldstein, MSW, is the Director of the Alliance to Advance Comprehensive Integrative Pain Management (AACIPM). She founded Healthcare Collaboratives, LLC, in 2019 to continue her passion for promoting person-centered health care through alliance building and strategic collaboration – always the foundation behind her work. Ms. Goldstein was previously the Director of State Pain Policy Advocacy Network and later Alliance Development Director for the Academy of Integrative Pain Management (AIPM). In that role, she was responsible for the creation, growth and sustainability of this national state-based and federal network to improve person-centered pain policy.

Ms. Goldstein has been in the healthcare field for 25 years, advocating for patients and families living with kidney failure, cancer, chronic pain, substance use disorder, mental health issues, and multiple sclerosis. She led the creation of sustained networks of action for patients, families, clinicians, and community members during her roles at the American Cancer Society as the Executive Director of the Hope Lodge in Quality Hill, Director of the Massachusetts Pain Initiative, and the Senior Director for New England Pain Initiatives; and as Senior Director for Programs, Services and Advocacy at the National Multiple Sclerosis Society, Mid America Chapter. She has served in numerous volunteer leadership, advisory and board positions.
