



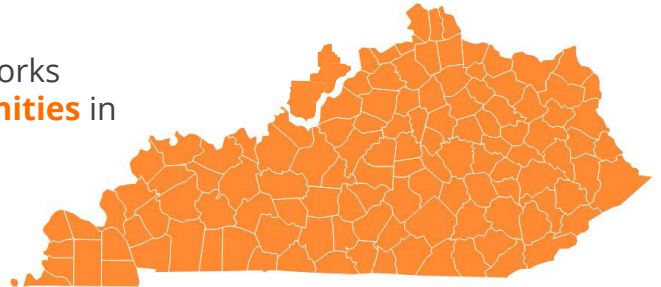

The Kentuckiana Health Collaborative works **collaboratively** to build **healthier communities** in Kentucky and Southern Indiana.



The Kentuckiana Health Collaborative (KHC) is a non-profit coalition of healthcare purchasers and stakeholders working to solve the complex health problems that face our local communities. The KHC was formed in 2003 by the UAW/Ford Community Healthcare Initiative and became a non-profit in 2011. In 2020, UAW/Ford Community Healthcare Initiative was closed and the KHC became an independent non-profit, updated its bylaws, established a new board framework, and hired its first president and CEO.

Mission

The mission of the KHC is to work collaboratively with healthcare purchasers and stakeholders to build healthier communities through high quality, affordable, and equitable healthcare across Kentucky and Southern Indiana.

Our vision is a more equitable system for health where all people in Kentucky and Southern Indiana have access to high quality and affordable healthcare.

Focus Areas

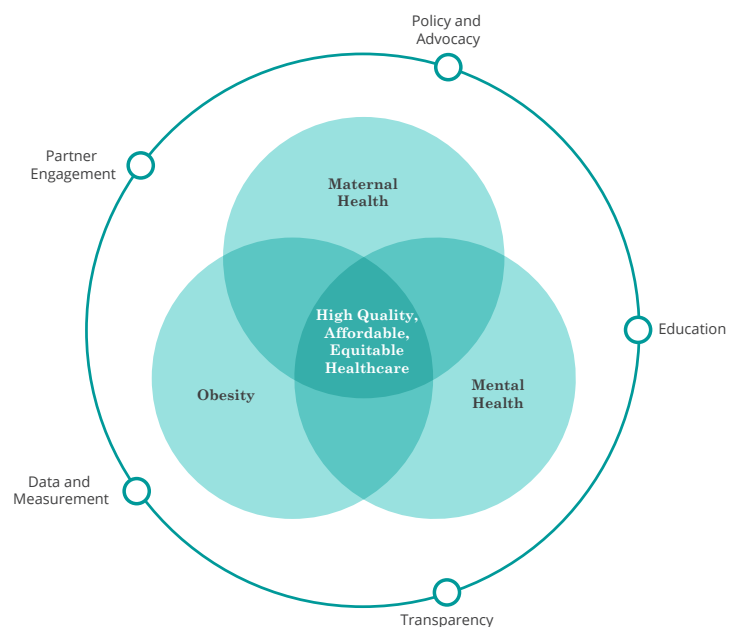
